


Present Simple & Progressive

Present Simple & Progressive

You will need different coloured counters and a die

Rules:

Each player chooses a coloured counter.

Each player in turn rolls the die and moves along the board according to the number on the die. If a player rolls a 3 he moves along to the third square and says a sentences using 'father', 'sit' and 'armchair'. For example, "Father sits on a blue armchair." "Father is sitting on a blue armchair." "Father sat on a blue armchair."

It is the next player's turn.

If a player lands on a square with a green arrow, the player says a sentence using the words from the square he has landed on. Then the player moves down the arrow and says a sentence with the words from that square. If a player lands on a blue arrow, the player says a sentence using the words from the square he has landed on. Then the player moves up the arrow and says a sentence with the words from that square.

The player who reaches 'FINISH' first is the winner.
