When do you use 'in to'?

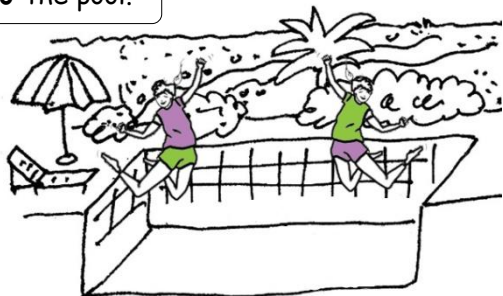
You use 'into' to show movement.

She went **in to** buy some new clothes.
