How to play:

Cut up all the cards from pages 1 to 4.

Activity: Shuffle the cards and place them face up in the middle of the group.
Let each student in turn find a correct sentence.

Example: 'Aunt Betty ____ (go) to a party last week' and 'went'.
This is an activity not a game. There is no winner

Game: Shuffle the cards and place them face down in the middle of the group.
Each student in turn, picks up two cards and reads them.

Example: 'Aunt Betty ____ (go) to a party last week' and 'did'. This is not a pair, so the student places them face down. If the student picks up 'Aunt Betty ____ (go) to a party last week' and 'went', this is a pair and the student keeps the pair.

It is now the next student's turn.

The student with the most pairs at the end is the winner.
