You do know how to use Tag Questions, don't you?

When using Tag Questions, remember four points:

We use **Tag Questions** to: confirm or check information



#### 1 - Tenses

You eat breakfast every day, don't you?
You ate lunch yesterday, didn't you?
You will eat dinner this evening, won't you?

temps

tiempos

What tense is the verb? (present, past, future, etc.)

#### 2 - Verbs

You are hungry, aren't you?
You do your homework every day, don't you?
You haven't eaten this before, have you?
You shouldn't drive today, should you?
You can write in English, can't you?

verbes

What kind of verb is it? (to be/to do/to have/should/can)



# 3 - Positive or Negative

#### 4 - Pronouns

(Mary = she)



## Rule #1

regla 1 מוק אספר 1

London is the capital city of England, isn't it?
Sally was at home last night, wasn't she?
You are coming to visit me, aren't you?

règle 1

If the main clause of the question is positive the tag question will be negative.



### Rule #2

regla 2 מוק אספר 2

Tom didn't do his homework, did he? Sally wasn't at home last night, was she? You aren't coming to visit me, are you?

règle 2

If the main clause of the question is negative the tag question will be positive.



#### Our Family

My mum drives to work every day, doesn't she? My dad isn't picking me up from school today, is he? My sister didn't take my book, did she? My brother wasn't at home at the time, was he? My grandma will come to visit tomorrow, won't she? My grandpa is coming with her, isn't he? I have a wonderful family, don't I?!

# Up and Down Tag Questions

#### How to play

Each player has a counter.

- •The players place their counters on START.
- •One player starts by rolling the die. He/She moves along the board according to the number shown on the die. For example: the player rolls a '4'. The player lands on 'He agreed to help you...'
- •That player reads the sentence and jumps to the Tag Question in square number 5, and finishes the question. For example, "He agreed to help you, didn't he?"
- If a player rolls the die and lands on the Tag Question, he/she moves back to the first square with the beginning sentence and then jumps to the Tag Question. For example, if the player rolls a three, that player moves back to square number 2, reads the sentence and then jumps to square number 12 to finish the Tag Question.
- It is then the next player's turn.
- •The above rules apply for the remainder of the game.
- •The players go up and down arrows on the way to the winning square.
- •The player who reaches You aren't the winner... ... are you? Yes, I am the winner. is the winner.
