Colour Change

Shuffle the cards and deal eight cards to each player.

Place the remaining cards in a pack face down in the middle of the group. Turn over the top card, this is the discard pile.

The players look at the cards in their hand.

Each player discards a card (or cards), in turn, onto the top card, by either matching its colour; matching its number; using one of the 'special cards'. If the player doesn't have a card, a card must be picked up from the pack. When a player places a card on the pile, he/she completes the sentence, for example, [Mr. Black _____ (**not study**) for a test at the moment.] "Mr. Black **is not studying** for a test at the moment".

The player to finish his cards first is the winner.

Special cards:



: "STOP!" The next player misses his/her turn.



: "CHANGE COLOUR TO...!" The player changes the colour.



: "COLOUR!" The player adds all the cards of the same colour.

: "CHANGE DIRECTIONS!" This card changes the direction of play.



: "PLUS!" The player has another turn.



: "TAKE 2!" The next player takes 2 cards from the pack.
