When do you use 'this' and when do you use 'these'?

When do you use 'that' and when do you use 'those'?

You use 'this' and 'these' to talk about people or things that are near you. This is used in the singular and these in the plural.

You use that and those to talk about people or things that are far from you. That is used in the singular and those in the plural.

## Examples:
