R.A.F.T. Writing - This activity changes a normal assignment where the student writes a formal essay or report into a fun assignment using different roles, audiences, formats and topics.

The ideas are endless for this type of activity. Go for it and make your own.

I am sharing one of the pages I made for my 8th-grade students.

This writing activity was much more of a challenge and my students really made a go of it.

The students had to roll the die for each part.

One student wrote a short diary entry as an artist, telling the jury why she thought one should read more books.

I recommend this activity for 8th-grade students and above.

You can make the activity easier by letting the students choose each part without rolling the die.
